**Celebrating the Cuisine of the African Diaspora**

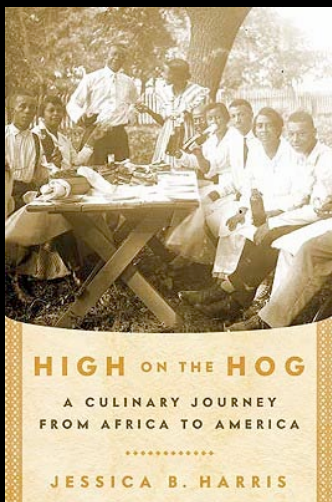
